

Types of sessions

- Technical session
- Commercial Presentation and/or Marketing and/or Product
- Internal Presentation
- **Academic Presentation**
- Training
- What do all of these have in common?
 - A speaker

Types of sessions

- All sessions are not the same.
 - No!!!
- We do not control the various types of environment.
 - Number of participants
 - We do not control the premises
 - We do not control equipment that does not belong to us
 - We do not control the Internet connection (Firewall, filters, blocking, among others)
 - ...
- We must have contingency plans
 - Video / audio adapters (VGA, HDMI, mic jack extension cable, ...)
 - Electric extensions.
 - Copy of presentation (USB flash drive, USB hard drive, Cloud storage, ...)
 - Internet connection (For example: Hotspot, mobile phone, ...)
 - Ethernet cable (Wi-Fi is slow, limited, requires specific configuration, ...)



- Dialogue of a speaker
 - Expressive
 - Use clear language
 - Variation of tone of voice
 - Active Speaker -> active audience
- Jokes
 - Introduction of moment of humor
- Avoid everything related with!!!
 - Gender
 - Religious orientation or religious expressions
 - Sexual orientation
 - Roots (ethnic)
 - ...

Try not to use (to childish)

Solution Wirtual Switches

- → Hyper-V Virtual Switch is a software-based Layer-2 network switch
- Private
 - ⊕ Can create unlimited private virtual switches
- - ⊕ Can create unlimited Internal virtual switches
- - ⊕ Each external virtual switch is connected to Ethernet or wireless adapter.
- → VLAN, DHCP Guard, Network Traffic mirroring



W Virtual Switches

- Hyper-V Virtual Switch is a software-based Layer-2 network switch that we can use to connect the virtual machines to the host computer or physical networks. And he can create several types of virtual switch
- Private, this virtual switch option only allows that virtual machines talks with others virtual machines, but is not possible to talks with the host or any physical network. We can create unlimited private virtual switches
- Internal, this virtual switch option allows that virtual machines talks with each virtual machines an with any virtual machine or the host but is not possible to access to any physical network. We can create unlimited internal virtual switches.
- ⊕ External, this virtual switch option allow the virtual machine to talk to any host, computer or defined network (Host Ethernet or Host Wi-Fi). But we can only create one external virtual switch for every network hardware available in the host.
- Traffic mirroring are network functionality available in Hyper-V.


- Murphy's law will always be present
